

Visitor rules of Equestrian Centre Deurne

By entering Equestrian Centre Deurne visitors accept the applicability of this regulations. With "Equestrian Centre Deurne" is meant all the buildings, the catering industry and the outdoor grounds among which access roads, parking lot and bicycle parking. Equestrian Centre Deurne is hereafter mentioned as ECD.

Access

- Access to ECD is only allowed by showing a valid entrance ticket and/or identity papers/card.
- Children under the age of 16 are only allowed to visit ECD when accompanied by an adult. Identification is required.
- In case of huge crowds the amount of visitors can be limited.
- ECD can deny access to visitors who are or seem to be a threat for the order, peace and security on or around ECD without that ECD is being held for any compensation.


Parking


- With events ECD will charge parking fees.
- All kinds of vehicles need to be parked at the indicated places.
- When parked outside the indicated parking spaces vehicles will be towed away.

Code of conduct (general)

- On and around ECD instructions from staff of ECD need to be strictly followed.
- ECD can (let) make image and/or sound recordings of the location and the people on and around the location. ECD and the affiliated companies are entitled to use and publish these recordings, for example for promotional purposes. Of course, ECD and its affiliates will take the necessary care. ECD and its affiliated companies are no compensation obligated for the use and publication of the recordings to the persons shown thereon. If you do not want to appear in the picture, avoid the places where you see a filmmaker, film crew and/or photographer at work.
- It is **not** allowed on or around ECD to:
 - make image and/or sound recordings for commercial purposes without permission of the organization;
 - carry weapons or drugs;
 - show, in the opinion of ECD, racist, intimidating, annoying or aggressive behavior;
 - wear, in the opinion of ECD, unkempt, immoral, offensive, group-characteristic and/or inflammatory clothing;
 - drink alcoholic products for people under the 18;
 - bring your own consumptions;
 - advertise;
 - do a survey or collect;
 - offer products or services;
 - carry out religious convictions or to hold demonstrations;
 - use electricity connections.
- ECD is a smoking free area, at the whole location it is forbidden to smoke.
- Do not leave any garbage at the location and put it in the dedicated containers.
- When animal cruelty is detected the organization can deny access to the location to the persons involved.
- Members of the press must present themselves to the organization on arrival.
- Photographers can only enter the ring during the award ceremony unless agreed otherwise with the organization.
- It is not allowed to enter the location with animals/pets with the exception of horses and dogs. Dogs must be on a leash and are not allowed inside the buildings.

- ECD sells or does not give alcohol to guests under the age of 18. Identification is required.
- ECD reports criminal offenses on or around the location to the police.

Code of conduct (stabling, horses and training)

- The passport of every horse stabled at ECD needs to be handed in at the reception on arrival (regulations NVWA).
- All horses visiting ECD need to be vaccinated at least according to the rules of the Dutch Equestrian Federation (KNHS).
- Loading and unloading of horses is only allowed at the parking lot.
- Riders, amazons and riders on and behind a horse must wear an appropriate attached helmet at all times.
- Every companion, rider, amazon or groom is responsible that manure is removed from the location immediately and is deposited in the dedicated containers.
- The FNRS arena rules for riders and rules for hacking should be observed at all time.
- Lunging is only allowed in the designated areas (circle's outside).
- Do not walk on the grass with your horse, use the indicated paths.
- It is not allowed to use the natural obstacles at the location.
- Do not let your horse bite on fences and arena edges.
- The use of alcohol before or during riding is not allowed.
- During lessons and when riders, amazons and coachmen are riding otherwise it needs to be quiet and calm in and around the riding areas.
- Except for the riders, amazons and the instructors who take part in lessons, nobody can interfere with the lessons.
- It is not allowed to interfere with the way of doing business, keeping and training horses of others.
- Obstacles must be put away every day (out of the riding area) when finished using them;
- Stable corridors need to be empty. Wheelbarrows, buckets, forage, harnesses and such may not stand or hang in the corridors.
- Lights in the stables should be turned off when leaving the stable.
- Lights in the training areas must to be turned off when finished training.
- Paddocks can be used with a maximum of half an hour per horse.
- Horse food, hay and straw must be bought at ECD preferred suppliers.


Organizers


- ECD makes her accommodation available to third parties for the organization of events. The organizer of the event is mentioned on the website of ECD. By purchasing an entrance ticket for an event from an external organizer, the guest enters into an agreement with another party and not with ECD. An external organizer is not affiliated with ECD and does not apply as a subordinate or auxiliary person of ECD and/or the Libéma concern.

Liability

- ECD is not liable for personal injury and/or theft, loss, missing or damage to belongings of a guest arising during and/or as a result of a visit to an event by an external organizer as described above.
- Entering ECD is at your own risk. ECD is not liable for the cause and the consequences of accidents, personal injury and/or theft, loss, missing or damage to belongings of a guest arising during and/or as a result of a visit to ECD, except insofar caused as a result of intent or conscious recklessness on the part of (the management of) ECD.
- ECD is not liable for consequential damage, including business damage and loss of income.
- In so far as ECD does not appeal to the aforementioned liability limitations, ECD is fully liable up to the amount paid out under the liability insurance in the case in question, including the amount of the excess.
